- We have established stable and long-term relationships with local suppliers to foster mutual development through continuous collaboration.

Supplier Assessments

- We incorporate environmental and social impact factors into the supplier assessment criteria, establishing a comprehensive evaluation system to ensure high standards and quality among our partners.
- We require our suppliers to comply with all applicable laws and regulations, including labor laws, environmental regulations, and human rights protections.
- Suppliers identified with significant negative impacts during assessments will be required to take immediate corrective actions. Suppliers that fail to comply or whose corrective actions are insufficient will have their partnerships terminated and be removed from our supplier list.

Supplier Development Programs

- We have a supplier development program that clearly outlines goals and performance measures.
- We provide diverse support to suppliers, such as professional training sessions and communication seminars, to help them continuously enhance product quality and service levels.
- We track and evaluate our suppliers' performance to ensure that the development program is meeting expectations.

Scope of Application

The Procurement Policy applies to Silvercorp Metals Inc., its direct business activities, subsidiaries, and contractors.
